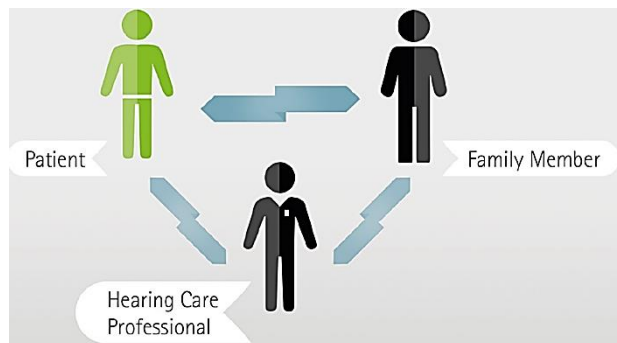

Jill Preminger, Ph.D., received her master's degree in Audiology from the University of Wisconsin in 1982 and her Ph.D. in Audiology from the University of Minnesota in 1993. She has been on the faculty in the Program of Audiology at the University of Louisville since 1998. She now serves as the Chief of the Division of Communicative Disorders and the Director of the Program in Audiology.

Currently, Dr. Preminger is a Member of the Phonak Patient and Family Centered Care Expert Circle and she is the principal investigator of a grant to determine if an Internet-Based Self-Management Program will increase the uptake of audiology services in adults with unaddressed hearing impairment? She has over 35 peer-reviewed publications. She has an active clinical research program which is focused on adult audiologic rehabilitation.
